

How to make a tall Royal Cone Hat:

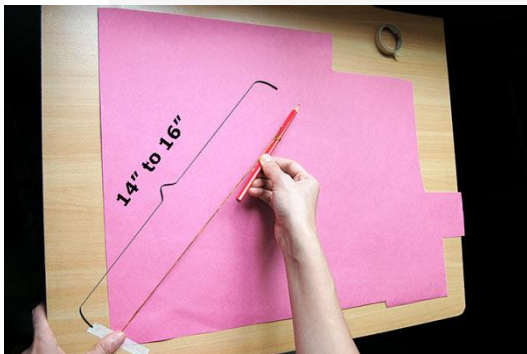

The library will have construction paper already cut to a cone shape and streamers available for your hat!

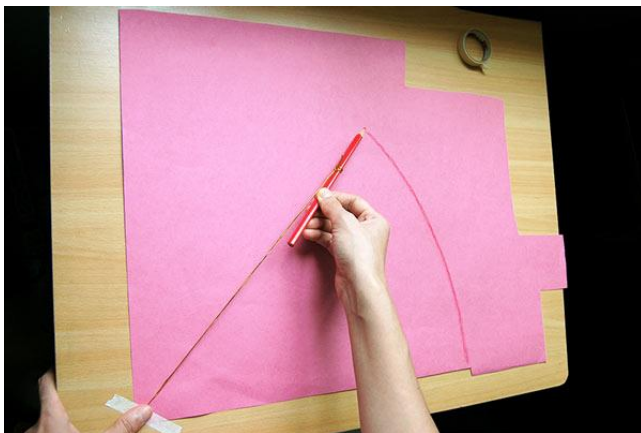
SUPPLIES NEEDED

- Construction paper (12" x 18")
- Scissors
- String
- Pencil
- Masking tape
- Ruler
- White glue
- Stapler

• STEPS



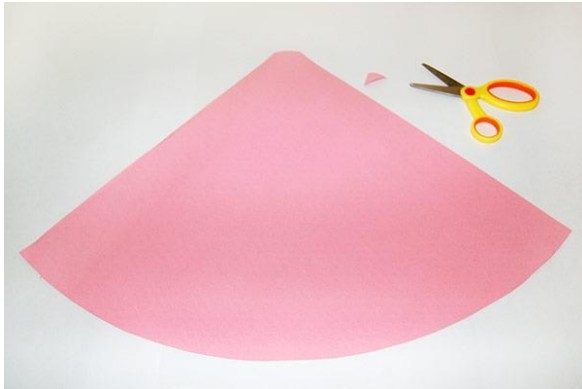
- **1** Create a large compass.
- Tie the end of a piece of string around the middle of a pencil. Make sure that the other end of the string all the way to the tip of the pencil is at least 14 to 16 inches long. (Use a longer string if you need a larger cone hat.)



- **2** Draw an arc.
- Use tape or your thumb to keep the free end of the string on the corner of your construction paper. While pulling tightly, draw an arc from one edge of the paper to the adjacent edge, forming a quarter circle.

- **3 Cut along the arc.**
- Cut the paper along the arc. Position the quarter circle so that the arc is at the bottom and the tip is on top.

- **4 Trim the tip.**
- If you want to add some decorations at the top of your cone hat (e.g. streamers or veil for a princess cone hat), trim a little bit off the tip.



-
- **5 Tape the decorations.**
- Gather your decorations together (e.g. several strips of crepe paper) on one end. Tape this end onto the tip of your quarter circle.
- Feel free to color or glue decorations to your Royal Hat!
